

# Auckland Council's rukenga kai (food scraps) collection service

**Recycling your food scraps is simple, give it a try!**

Auckland's food scraps will be delivered to a processing facility where they will be turned into liquid fertiliser, and replace imported synthetic fertilisers used on neighbouring farms, reducing carbon footprints.



To help keep your kitchen caddy clean, you can line it with newspaper or an Auckland Council compostable bin liner.



All food scraps can be recycled including bones, meat, dairy, bread and fruit peel. Put them in your kitchen caddy during the week.



Tie the liner closed and place into your food scraps bin. Empty the caddy into your food scraps collection bin regularly during the week if it's getting smelly.



Put your food scraps kerbside bin out for collection at the same time as your weekly rubbish bin. Leave space between bins.
